MULTIPLY The Command to Make Disciples - Session 2

1. Stop for a minute and read Matthew 28. Try to place yourself in the disciples' shoes as they witnessed these things and heard these words from Jesus. How do you think you would have reacted?

2. Assess your church experience in light of Jesus' command to make disciples. Would you say that your church is characterized by disciple making? Why or why not?

3. Have you identified yourself with Jesus through being baptized? If so, why do think this was an important step for you to take? If not, what is holding your back from being baptized?

4. Would you say that you're ready to commit yourself to studying the Scriptures and investing in the people around you? Why or why not?

5. What excuses tend to keep you from following Jesus' command to make disciples? What do you need to do in order to move past these excuses?

6. Whom has God placed in your life right now that you can begin making into a disciple of Jesus Christ?

7. Whom has God placed in your life for you to partner with in making disciples?
